

# Dimensions of cold aisles for railway communication



## Article Overview

Cold aisles should generally be 1.2 meters wide with lengths up to 16 meters, with containment systems used to optimize airflow and equipment cooling.

### Recommended Width and Length

For effective cooling and accessibility, cold aisles are typically designed with a minimum width of 1.2 meters, allowing sufficient space for personnel to access equipment and for airflow between racks or cabinets . The maximum aisle length is generally 16 meters when both ends are open, but if one end is closed or lacks an exit, the length should be limited to 6 meters to ensure safe access and evacuation . These dimensions help maintain thermal performance and operational safety.

### Containment and Airflow Management

Cold aisle containment involves enclosing the aisle in front of equipment racks to direct cold air precisely into server or communication equipment intakes . This prevents mixing of cold supply air with hot exhaust air, maintaining uniform and predictable temperatures across all racks. Containment systems can include floor-mounted frames, modular panels, and doors, which allow controlled access while preserving airflow efficiency .
