Overview

What's the recommended minimal distance between the rack and the wall?

For Sliding Rack Mount's optimal experience, a minimum distance of 15 cm (around 6 inches) is required between the rack and a flat wall. As the definition states, a server rack is a multi-level furniture piece designed to accommodate telecommunication equipment, cross-countries, and termination points for transmission media.
