

Distance between power cables and optical cables



Article Overview

Maintain a minimum of 2 inches (50 mm) separation for parallel runs, with greater distances recommended for high-voltage or high-current circuits, and cross cables at 90 degrees whenever possible.

Minimum Separation Guidelines

For parallel runs, the National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies a minimum separation of 2 inches (50 mm) between communication cables, including optical fiber, and power cables to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI) and ensure safety . This baseline applies to typical low-voltage communication circuits, such as Category 5e/6 or optical fiber, running alongside standard power circuits. For high-voltage or high-current power cables, best engineering practice often recommends increasing the separation, sometimes up to 12 inches or more, especially for long parallel runs, to maintain signal integrity and reduce induced noise . In cases where wide separation is not feasible, barriers or shielding can be used to mitigate EMI .

Crossing Cables

When power and optical cables must cross each other, the NEC allows them to intersect perpendicularly at a 90-degree angle, which minimizes the length of parallel exposure and reduces inductive coupling. At these crossing points, the 2-inch minimum separation is generally not required
