

Distribution box control voltage

Voltage in a distribution box can be controlled using voltage regulators, tap-changing transformers, and Volt/VAR control systems to maintain stable and safe voltage levels for downstream loads.

Using Voltage Regulators

Voltage regulators are devices installed in series with the distribution line to add or subtract voltage as needed, ensuring that the voltage at the load remains within acceptable limits. They typically operate with multiple taps (e.g., 16 raise taps, a neutral position, and 16 lower taps) to adjust voltage in small increments, often around 0.75 V per tap on a 120 V system . Regulators can be uni-directional, affecting only the load side, and are designed to correct voltage drops caused by real current flow . Modern regulators can also integrate features like reverse power flow detection for networks with distributed generation .

Tap-Changing Transformers

Tap-changing transformers allow voltage adjustment by switching the transformer winding configuration. They can be off-load (adjusted when no current flows) or on-load (adjusted under full load). Typical step sizes for distribution transformers are 2.5%, with finer adjustments of 1.25–1.5% possible in transmission substations. This allows the voltage at the supply end to be maintained within $\pm 10\%$ of the rated output . The tap changer is often controlled automatically based on voltage sensing to maintain consistent output....
