A cable ladder serves as a structured support system to route cables safely to a distribution box, where cables are terminated or connected to electrical circuits.

Purpose of the Connection

The connection between a cable ladder and a distribution box ensures that electrical cables are organized, supported, and protected as they transition from horizontal or vertical routing into the distribution equipment. This setup prevents mechanical stress on the cables, reduces the risk of damage, and maintains compliance with safety and electromagnetic compatibility (EMC) standards .

Physical Integration

- **Cable Entry:** Cables are typically routed along the ladder and enter the distribution box through designated knockouts or cable glands. These entry points secure the cables and maintain the box's integrity against dust, moisture, and mechanical strain .
- **Supports and Fittings:** The ladder may use trapeze, swing, or center-hung supports to maintain alignment and load distribution. The last section of the ladder near the distribution box often includes transition fittings or tray clips to guide cables smoothly into the box without sharp bends .
- **Spacing and Load Considerations:** Proper spacing of supports ensures that the cable weight is evenly distributed, preventing sagging or excessive stress at the entry point of the distribution box. Maximum load per hanger and support spacing should be adhered to according to manufacturer specifications
