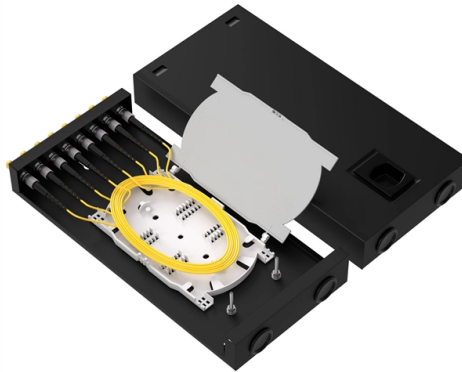


Do fiber optic patch panels need junction boxes
