Without a router, devices cannot communicate with each other or access the internet wirelessly.

Whole-Home Coverage Considerations

For larger homes, a single router may not provide sufficient Wi-Fi coverage. In such cases, mesh Wi-Fi systems or additional access points can be added to extend coverage and maintain strong signal strength throughout the house . The router should ideally be placed in a central location to maximize coverage.

Not all routers are compatible with fiber connections. A fiber-ready router or gateway is required to handle the high speeds and specific input from the ONT . Some ISPs p...
