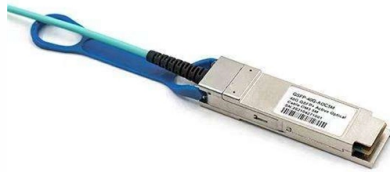

- **Solid Partitions:** Provide physical separation and protection, commonly used in environments where visual aesthetics or additional cable protection is required .
