

Does the cable tray include the support frame



Article Overview

Cable trays generally do not come with a support frame; supports such as brackets, hangers, or suspension systems are usually purchased and installed separately.

Support Requirements

Cable trays are designed to carry and organize electrical cables, but they require additional support elements to be safely mounted. These supports include:

- Hangers, brackets, and clamps for standard or custom installations, which secure the tray to ceilings, walls, or other structures (TechLine Mfg.), .
- Hoisting frames and cross arms for overhead installations, with hoisting frames suited for small trays and cross arms for larger, heavier trays (Apex Tray), .
- Suspension rods that connect the tray to the ceiling or structural supports, often adjustable to accommodate different heights and loads .

Installation Guidelines

- Supports should be spaced according to tray type and load, typically every 1.5 to 2 meters for hoisting frames or cross arms .
- For vertical or horizontal bends, additional supports are recommended near extremities or at the center of long spans to maintain stability .
- Support elements are selected based on tray material (steel, FRP, or wire mesh), size, and the weight of cables to ensure structural integrity
