

Does the ground wire of a three-level distribution box need to be run through a conduit



Article Overview

The ground wire in a three-level distribution box does not always need to be run through a conduit, but it must be properly sized, continuous, and securely connected to ensure a low-impedance path for fault current.

NEC Requirements and Best Practices

The equipment grounding conductor (EGC) provides a low-impedance path for fault currents and ensures that overcurrent protective devices operate quickly during a fault, protecting both equipment and personnel . According to the NEC, the EGC can be a wire-type conductor that is run either inside a conduit or separately, as long as it is continuous, properly sized per Table 250.122, and bonded to all metal enclosures and equipment .

Conduit Considerations

Running the ground wire through a conduit is not strictly required by the NEC, but it is often recommended for:

- Mechanical protection: Prevents accidental damage to the wire in high-traffic or exposed areas.
- System continuity: Ensures all metal enclosures and raceways are bonded togeth...
