Drilling Procedure

- **Marking:** Use a chalk line or laser level to mark the tray sections where holes are needed for supports, splice plates, or accessories. Ensure alignment with the tray's side rails or flanges .
- **Hole Size:** Drill clearance holes according to the hardware size, commonly 3/8" for side rails or as specified by the manufacturer .
- **Drilling:** Drill through the tray material carefully, maintaining perpendicular align...
