

Dual PoE switches connected in series



Article Overview

Yes, dual PoE switches can be connected in series (daisy-chained) using standard Ethernet cables, but careful attention to power budgets, PoE standards, and network configuration is essential.

How to Connect PoE Switches in Series

- **Use the Uplink or LAN Ports:** Connect the first PoE switch to your main network or router. Then, link the second PoE switch to the first using a standard Ethernet cable. Modern switches with auto-MDI/MDI-X ports simplify this process, as they automatically detect the cable type needed for the connection .
- **Power Budget Considerations:** Each PoE switch has a maximum power output per port and a total power budget. Ensure that the combined power requirements of all connected devices do not exceed the switch's capacity. If the second switch draws more power than the first can supply, some devices may not receive adequate power .
- **PoE Standards Compatibility:** Verify that both switches support compatible PoE standards (IEEE 802.3af, 802.3at, or 802.3bt). Using mismatched standards can limit the power delivered to devices or prevent some devices from functioning properly .
- **Network Configuration:** For managed switches, configure VLANs, Quality of Service (QoS), and other network settings to ensure proper communication between switches and connected devices. Unmanaged switches require minimal configuration but offer less control over traffic and power allocation .
- **Cable Selection:** Use high-quality Ethernet cables, preferably Cat6 or Cat6a, to support both data and power transmission efficiently, especially over longer distances .
- **Safety Precautions:** It is recommended to power off both switches before connecti...
