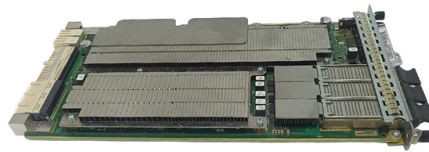

Cable Entry Protection

Use cable grommets or silicone dust plugs at all cable entry points to create tight seals and prevent dust from entering the box . Ensure grommets match the cable diameter for a secure fit. For unused ports, insert dust plugs to maintain the integrity of the enclosure.

Environmental Placement

Install boxes away from direct dust sources, ideally at least 1.5 meters from areas...
