A residential distribution box contains branch circuits for lighting, power outlets, and specialized appliances, each protected by circuit breakers or residual current devices.

Main Components and Circuit Types

A residential distribution box, also called a consumer unit or load center, receives incoming power from the utility and distributes it to multiple branch circuits throughout the home . The main components include:

- Main Switch: Controls the entire supply and allows isolation for maintenance or emergencies .
- Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs): Protect individual circuits from overcurrent and short circuits. Each MCB typically serves a specific branch circuit such as lighting, general power outlets, or small appliances .
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or RCBOs: Provide earth fault protection to prevent electric shock. RCBOs combine overcurrent and residual current protection in a single device .
- Busbars, Neutral, and Earth Bars: Distribute power to the outgoing circuits and provide proper grounding .
- Surge Protective Devices (SPD): Protect sensitive electronics from voltage spikes .
