OSFP (Octal Small Form-factor Pluggable) optical receivers support high-speed 400G to 1.6T Ethernet and InfiniBand networks, offering multi-lane PAM4 modulation, advanced thermal management, and broad reach capabilities.

Overview

The OSFP optical receiver is part of a high-performance transceiver family designed for next-generation data centers, hyperscale networks, and high-speed interconnects. OSFP modules are engineered to handle 400GbE, 800GbE, and even 1.6TbE connections, making them suitable for demanding applications such as AI, machine learning, and cloud infrastructure deployments .

Key Specifications

- **Data Rates:** OSFP modules support 400 Gbps (8x50 Gbps lanes), 800 Gbps (8x100 Gbps lanes), and up to 1.6 Tbps in dual-port configurations .
- **Modulation:** Uses PAM4 (Pulse Amplitude Modulation 4-level) for high spectral efficiency .
- **Reach:** Depending on the variant, OSFP receivers can operate over multi-mode fiber up to 100 meters, single-mode fiber up to 10 km, or specialized DR4/FR4 links for 500 meters to 2 km .
- **Receiver Sensitivity:** Typical maximum OMAouter sensitivity per lane is around -3.4 dBm for TECQ < 0.9 dB, with adjustments for stressed eye closure conditions .
- **Interface:** Digital diagnostics are accessible via I2C or two-wire serial interfaces, allowing monitoring of temperature, voltage, and optical power
