Overview

According to the NEC (National Electrical Code), all wire splices and electrical connections must be enclosed within an approved electrical junction box to ensure safety, accessibility, and code compliance. NEC Article 314 establishes requirements for the installation and use of electrical boxes, conduit bodies, fittings, and handhole enclosures. A conduit body is a removable-cover section of a conduit system that provides access at junctions or termination points. A junction box protects wire connections from physical damage, reduces shock and fire risks. Under the NEC, junction boxes must do more than simply contain splices.
