Electricity meters in EU distribution boxes are increasingly smart meters, integrated with distribution networks to enable real-time monitoring, energy management, and consumer participation in the energy transition.

Types of Meters and Deployment

In the EU, electricity meters installed in distribution boxes are predominantly Advanced Metering Systems (AMS), commonly referred to as smart meters. These meters automatically record electricity consumption in real-time and communicate data to both consumers and energy providers, replacing traditional manual meters. Smart meters are designed to support bidirectional communication, allowing consumers to sell self-generated renewable energy back to the grid and enabling distribution system operators (DSOs) to monitor and manage network performance more efficiently.

Regulatory Framework

The deployment of smart meters is guided by EU Directive 2019/944, which sets ambitious targets for member states to achieve 80% smart meter coverage by 2024, provided the rollout is cost-effective. National authorities regulate DSOs, who often own and manage the metering infrastructure, ensuring compliance with operational, security, and interoperability standards. The Implementing Regulation (EU) 2023/1162 further enhances access to metering and consumption data, promoting i...
