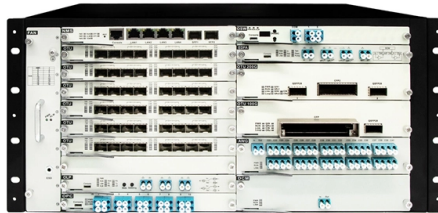


Ethernet cannot use optical splitters



Article Overview

Ethernet cannot use optical splitters because Ethernet signals are electrical, not optical, and optical splitters are designed to split light signals in fiber networks, not electrical signals in copper cables.

Technical Differences

Ethernet over copper cables transmits data as electrical signals through twisted pairs of wires. Standard Ethernet splitters work by leveraging unused wire pairs in a single cable to carry multiple 10/100 Mbps connections, but they are limited to electrical signal transmission and cannot handle light signals used in fiber optics . Optical splitters, on the other hand, are designed for fiber-optic networks, where data is transmitted as light. They divide the optical power from one fiber into multiple fibers, reducing signal strength according to the split ratio, but they do not convert light to electrical signals .

Limitations of Ethernet Splitters

Ethernet splitters are passive devices that only work with 10/100 Mbps connections using four of the eight wires in a cable. They cannot support Gigabit Ethernet, Power over Ethernet (PoE), or fiber-optic signals . Using an optical splitter with Ethernet would fail because the Ethernet device cannot interpret the light signal directly; it requires an optical transceiver to convert light into electrical signals.
