Labeling in fiber networks is the process of assigning consistent identifiers to cables, ports, splice locations, and distribution paths. Its purpose is operational rather than optical. Labeling systems help maintain: The optical signal itself is unaffected by labeling. They rely on two primary methods: durable physical markers like tags and labels for visual identification, and advanced electronic tools that can detect live signals in active cables. Four primary standards bodies define fiber optic labeling requirements in North America and globally: ANSI/TIA-568. Per TIA/EIA standards, the following color coding applies for non-military fiber optic installations: Multimode OM1 = Orange or Slate (Watch for this! OM1 is not compatible with connectors for.
