What Are Fiber Optic Connectors

A fiber optic connector is a mechanical device that aligns and joins optical fibers, allowing light to pass through efficiently. Unlike permanent splicing, connectors allow easy connection and disconnection, making them ideal for maintenance and flexible network configurations. Connectors are designed to minimize insertion loss and return loss, ensuring reliable signal transmission.

Common Connector Types

- SC (Subscriber Connector): Square-shaped with a push-pull mechanism, widely used in FTTH deployments and data centers. SC/APC variants are preferred for low return loss applications like GPON networks.
- LC (Lucent Connector): Miniaturized version of SC with a 1.25mm ferrule, ideal for high-density applications. Uses a latch mechanism similar to RJ45 plugs.
- ST (Straight Tip): Round connector with a bayonet-style twist lock, commonly used in legacy networks.
- MTP/MPO: Multi-fiber connectors for high-density environments, often used in data centers for parallel optics.
