

Fiber Optic Cable Connector Sealing

Sealing a fiber optic cable connector involves cleaning, applying appropriate epoxy or sealant, and securing the connector to prevent moisture and environmental damage while maintaining optical performance.

Step 1: Prepare the Fiber and Connector

- Remove the cable jacket and any shielding or armor to expose the fiber and strength members, following the manufacturer's instructions for your specific cable type .
- Clean the fiber and connector surfaces using alcohol wipes or a suitable cleaning solution to remove grease, dust, or debris .
- Abrade the outer cable jacket slightly (about 150mm) to ensure proper adhesion of the sealant or epoxy .

Step 2: Select and Apply the Sealant

- Choose the appropriate epoxy or adhesive for your application. Epoxies like ÅngströmBond® or other fiber-optic-specific two-part epoxies are recommended for their chemical and temperature resistance, low viscosity, and strong adhesion to fiber and connector materials .
- Mix the epoxy according to the manufacturer's instructions, ensuring the correct ratio and avoiding air bubbles. Use minimal quantities to reduce waste and ensure proper curing .
- Apply the epoxy to the connector interface or directly to the fiber as needed, ensuring complete coverage without excess height that could interfere with the con...
