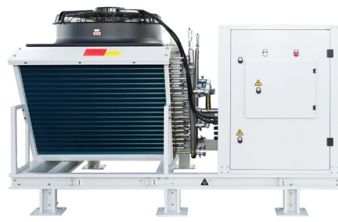


Fiber Optic Cable Heat Shrink Tubing Techniques

Key Components of Fiber Optic Heat Shrink Tubing

Fiber optic heat shrink tubing, often called a splice sleeve, typically consists of three integrated layers:

- **Outer Heat Shrinkable Tube:** Made from cross-linked polyolefin, this layer shrinks uniformly when heated to encapsulate the splice securely .
- **Inner Hot Melt Adhesive:** An EVA (Ethylene Vinyl Acetate) liner melts during heating to form a moisture-proof seal around the fiber, preventing water, dust, and humidity from affecting signal quality .
- **Reinforcement Rod:** Usually stainless steel or ceramic, this rigid rod provides mechanical strength to prevent micro-bending and breakage at the splice point .

Installation Techniques

- **Preparation:** Strip the protective coating from the fiber ends carefully, ensuring the glass fiber is clean and free of debris. Use a cleaver to achieve a precise cut for fusion splicing .
- **Positioning the Sleeve:** Slide the heat shrink tubing over the splice, centering the splice within the clear sleeve to allow visual inspection before heating
