Cable Marking

Fiber optic cables are typically identified using Fiber Mark cable markers, which are heavy-duty, pre-coiled plastic markers that snap into place without adhesive. These markers are designed to withstand UV exposure and abrasion, with text protected by a clear acrylic layer for durability. Common applications include:

- Routing identification in wiring ducts or conduit systems
- Safety warnings to prevent accidental damage or hazards
- Project documentation for maintenance and troubleshooting

Markers can be customized with legends such as “FIBER OPTIC CABLE” and are often repeated at regular intervals (e.g., every 6 inches) to ensure visibility along the cable run. Barricade tapes, such as HellermannTyton's 3-inch wide tapes, are also used for high-visibility marking in construction or restricted areas.
