 - Insert the connector gently until it clicks. If the module has a locking tab, engage it to secure the cable .
 - Maintain proper bend radius and avoid tension on the cable to prevent signal loss .
 5. Test the Connection
 - Use a visual fault locator or optical power meter to verify proper alignment and signal transmission....
