Fiber optic cable protective sheaths are designed to provide mechanical, environmental, chemical, and fire protection, with standards varying by material, application, and regulatory requirements.

Sheath Functions and Requirements

The outer sheath of a fiber optic cable serves as the primary protective layer, safeguarding the optical fibers from mechanical stress, bending, moisture, UV radiation, chemical exposure, and temperature fluctuations during installation and service life, which typically exceeds 20 years . Sheaths must also meet fire safety and toxicity standards, especially for indoor or plenum installations . Key performance requirements include:

- Mechanical protection: Resistance to crushing, impact, and rodent damage.
- Environmental resistance: UV, moisture, and temperature tolerance for outdoor applications.
- Chemical resistance: Protection against acids, alkalis, oils, and industrial chemicals.
- Fire performance: Flame retardancy, low smoke emission, and halogen-free properties for indoor safety compliance.

Common Sheath Materials and Standards

- PVC (Polyvinyl Chloride): Economical, flexible, and abrasion-resistant; suitable for general indoor use but limited in fire safety for plenum spaces
