

Fiber Optic Cable Splicing Operation Procedures Standard



Article Overview

Fiber optic splicing operations follow standardized procedures to ensure low splice loss, mechanical reliability, and compliance with international standards such as ITU-T L.12, Telcordia GR-771, and ISO 9001.

Preparation and Safety

Before splicing, technicians must ensure proper personal protective equipment (PPE), including gloves and eye protection, and verify that all tools and materials are available: fiber cleaver, stripper, fusion splicer, cleaning kit, heat-shrink sleeves, splice trays, and optical testing equipment such as OTDR and power meters (). Cable slack should be managed, and fiber routes and types (e.g., G.652D, G.655D) confirmed ().

Splicing Procedure

- Cable Preparation: Strip the outer jacket, buffer tube, and coating carefully. Clean the bare fiber with alcohol and lint-free wipes ().
- Fiber Cleaving: Use a precision cleaver to cut fibers at the correct angle to minimize splice loss ().
- Fusion Splicing: Insert fibers into the fusion splicer, verify auto-alignment, and perform the splice. Target splice loss is typically ≤ 0.1 dB ().
- Protection: Apply heat-shrink sleeves or protective coatings to the splice. Place fibers into splice trays without over-bending ().
- Mechanical Splicing (if used): Follow manufacturer instructions to align and secure...
