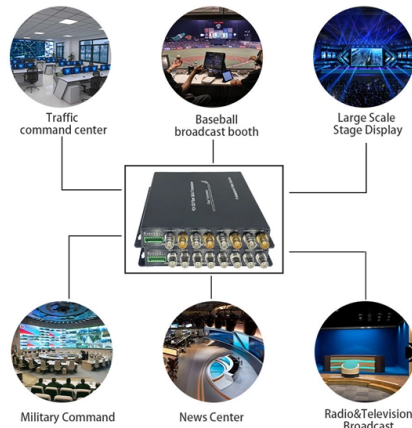


Fiber Optic Cable Type Calculation



Article Overview

Calculating fiber optic cable involves determining the total cable length, link loss, and power budget to ensure the network operates within acceptable limits.

Step 1: Determine Cable Length

Measure the actual cable path, including tray transitions, riser offsets, and bends. If only early-stage drawings are available, measure the centerline and add a routing slack of 3-10% to account for field adjustments and complex pathways. Include a service loop at termination points for maintenance and future moves, and a waste factor for trimming, damaged ends, or handling losses .

Step 2: Calculate Link Loss

The link loss is the total optical attenuation along the fiber, including fiber attenuation, connector loss, and splice loss. Use the following formula: Total Link Loss (dB) = (Fiber Loss per km × Cable Length in km) + (Number of Splices × Splice Loss) + (Number of Connector Pairs × Connector Loss)

- Fiber loss varies by type and wavelength: single-mode fiber typically has ~0.35 dB/km at 1310 nm and ~0.22 dB/km at 1550 nm .
- Splice loss: fusion splices
