

Fiber Optic Channel Parameter Settings



Article Overview

Fiber optic channel parameters include link speed, distance, buffer credits, FEC settings, and connector/wiring standards to ensure reliable high-speed data transmission.

Key Parameters for Fibre Channel Links

1. Link Speed and SFP Compatibility

- Fibre Channel links support multiple speeds depending on the SFP used: 2, 4, 8, 10, 16, and 32 Gbps are common on Cisco MDS and Nexus switches .
- Each SFP module supports only specific speeds; for example, a 16 Gbps SFP supports 16, 8, and 4 Gbps, but not 32 Gbps . Configuring unsupported speeds can cause link failures.

2. Distance and Link Budget

- Maximum unrepeated distance depends on fiber type (multimode or single-mode) and link budget, which accounts for fiber attenuation, connector loss, and splicing loss .
- Multimode fiber may require mode conditioning patch cables (MCP) for certain links to maintain signal integrity .
- Longer distances can be achieved using repeaters, switches, or channel extenders.
