Fusion splicing requires precise fiber preparation, accurate alignment, controlled splicing conditions, and proper protection to ensure low optical loss and long-term mechanical stability.

Fiber Preparation

Proper fiber preparation is critical for a successful fusion splice. The fiber coating must be stripped carefully using precision strippers appropriate for the fiber diameter (typically 250 μ m for bare fibers and 900 μ m for coated fibers) to avoid microfractures or damage to the glass core . The recommended strip length is usually between 10–20 mm depending on the splicer specifications. After stripping, the fiber ends must be thoroughly cleaned with isopropyl alcohol to remove dust, oil, or other contaminants, as even microscopic debris can degrade splice quality . A precision cleaver is then used to create a flat, perpendicular end face, as the cleave quality directly affects splice loss .

Alignment and Splicing

Fusion splicing aligns two fibers and fuses them using a controlled electric arc. Modern fusion splicers are mostly automated, but proper setup is essential. The splicer requires preset parameters or factory-recommended settings to control the arc duration, intensity, and alignment process . Accurate alignment minimizes insertion loss and reflectance, which is especially critical for single-mode fibers and long-distance networks . Misalignment can lead to increased optical loss and reduced long-term reliability....
