Fiber optic patch cord markings indicate fiber type, mode, core diameter, jacket material, production date, length, and connector type, often combined with color coding for quick identification.

Printed Markings

Fiber optic patch cords typically have printed information along the cable jacket that conveys key attributes:

- Fiber Mode: Single-mode (SM) or Multi-mode (MM), with multi-mode types including OM3, OM4, and OM5 .
- Core Diameter: Common sizes are 9 μm for single-mode, 50 μm or 62.5 μm for multi-mode .
- Outer Jacket Material: Materials like PVC (polyvinyl chloride) or LSZH (low smoke zero halogen) are indicated, affecting flame resistance and indoor/outdoor suitability .
- Production Date: Shows when the cable was manufactured, useful for maintenance planning .
- Length Markings: Some cords include length indicators along the jacket .
- Branding: Manufacturer or brand names may also be printed .
- Diameter: Typical patch cord diameters are 2.0 mm (LC connectors) or 3.0 mm (other connectors), .
