Role in Telecommunications and Connectivity

Fiber optic sensors form the backbone of the DRC's digital infrastructure, enabling high-speed, high-capacity data transmission across long distances. Major projects, such as the 5,745 km fiber optic backbone supported by Facebook and Sofrecom, and the 1,200 km network by Bandwidth and Cloud Services (BCS) backed by the European Investment Bank, illustrate the deployment of fiber networks to connect schools, hospitals, and urban centers . These sensors detect signal loss, monitor network integrity, and ensure reliable broadband delivery, which is critical in a country where internet penetration remains below 24% and mobile broadband coverage is limited .

In cities like Mbanza-Ngungu, fiber optic sensors are integrated into metropolitan fiber rings to create resilient, scalable digital backbones .
