

Fiber Optic Switch Network Configuration

Configuring a fiber optic network switch involves selecting the correct SFP transceivers, connecting duplex fiber cables, configuring switch ports, and setting VLANs to ensure proper network operation.

Hardware Preparation

- **Select SFP Modules:** Choose SFP or SFP+ transceivers compatible with your switch and fiber type. For multimode fiber, use OM3 modules; for single-mode fiber, use OS2 modules. Ensure the module supports the desired bandwidth (1G, 10G, or higher) and features duplex LC connections .
- **Fiber Cabling:** Use duplex fiber optic cables with LC connectors. When connecting two switches, reverse the connections between the SFP ports (A to B, B to A) to ensure proper send/receive signal alignment .
- **Check Switch Compatibility:** Confirm that the switch supports fiber ports or has expansion modules for Fibre Channel or FCoE if required .

Switch Configuration Steps

- **Connect to the Switch:** Use an Ethernet cable to connect your computer to the switch. Assign an IP address in the same subnet as the switch .
- **Access the CLI:** Log in using a terminal client like PuTTY and enter the switch's IP address .
- **Configure Basic Settings:** Set the hostname, enable password, user password, and switch IP address .
- **Configure Fiber Ports:** Enable the fiber-optic ports, set the correct speed and duplex mode, and ensure the ports are active . For Fibre Channel switches, configure port modes (F, E, TE, SD) and assign VSANs as needed ...
