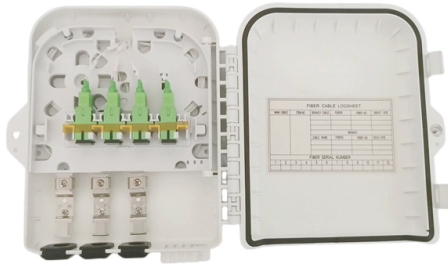


Fiber Optic Terminal Box Model Parameters

Key Parameters and Features

1. Fiber Capacity and Termination

- FTB-SC8-WOPA: Supports termination for at least 8 users, suitable for small FTTx deployments, with space for splicing, splitting, and fiber storage .
 - FTB Max: High-density solution terminating up to 168 fibers, with 24 fibers spliced directly and the remainder in cassettes; can also function as a pure splice distribution box .
 - FTB Speed: Flexible for multi-dwelling units, accommodates splicing, patching, and splitter options, designed for reduced installation effort .
 - FTB Connect: Indoor/outdoor use, 10 ports, supports splicing, patching, and splitters, with access from all four sides .
 - ORM 1: Designed for 2–4 fibers at a customer terminal point, suitable for indoor wall mounting .
 - DIN Rail Mounted Box (NORDEN): Supports various optical fiber systems, suitable for mini-network terminal distribution, with adapter ports for FC, ST, LC, SC connectors .
