These ports are preferred for long-distance connections, high bandwidth (1Gbps or 10Gbps), reduced electromagnetic interference, and future-proof network expansion . Switches may have built-in fiber ports or modular SFP/SFP+ slots that allow flexibility in choosing the connection type .

Choosing the Right SFP Module

SFP (Small Form-Factor Pluggable) modules determine the medium and speed of the uplink. Key considerations include:

- Speed: SFP (1 Gbps) or SFP+ (10 Gbps) depending on network requirements .
- Fiber Type: Single-mode for long distances or multi-mode for shorter distances .
- Connector Type: LC connectors are common; ensure the polish type matches the transceiver to avoid excessive optical return loss .
- Compatibility: Use manufacturer-approved SFPs to prevent unpredictable behavior and ensure link stability
