

# Fiber optic access point connected to router



## Article Overview

To connect a router to a fiber optic access point, you typically use an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) to convert the fiber signal to Ethernet, then link it to your router's WAN port for high-speed internet access.

### Required Equipment

- Optical Network Terminal (ONT): Converts incoming fiber optic signals into electrical signals compatible with your router .
- Fiber optic cable: Usually single-mode with SC/APC or SC/UPC connectors .
- Router: Ensure it supports gigabit or multi-gigabit speeds; some routers have SFP/SFP+ ports for direct fiber input .
- Ethernet cable (Cat6a or higher): Connects the ONT to the router to maintain high-speed performance .

### Step-by-Step Connection

- Install the ONT: Connect the fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT and power it on. Wait for the status lights to stabilize, indicating a proper connection .
- Link ONT to Router: Use an Ethernet cable to connect the ONT's LAN port to the router's WAN port. Power on the router and verify connectivity through indicator lights or the router's web interface .
- Configure Router Settings: Access the router's configuration page (commonly 192.168.0.1 or 192.168.1.1) to set up network parameters, enable Quality of Service (QoS) if needed, and ensure optimal performance for streaming, gaming, or multipl...
