Overview

A fiber optic box, also known as a fiber terminal box or distribution box, is designed to terminate fiber optic cables and manage connections in a secure, organized manner. Inside the box, fiber pigtails—short lengths of fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other—are used to connect incoming fiber cables to network equipment or patch panels. The bare fiber end is typically fusion spliced or mechanically spliced to the incoming fiber, while the connector end plugs into adapters, transceivers, or patch cords.

Structure and Function

- **Splice Tray or Holder:** The box contains a tray to hold and protect spliced fibers, preventing bending or damage.
- **Multiple Pigtails:** Each pigtail corresponds to a fiber core in the incoming cable. For example, a 4-core cable can be connected to four pigtails, which then lead to four patch cables or network ports.
- **Connector Types:** Common pigtail connectors include LC, SC, ST, and FC, chosen based on equipment compatibility and network requirements.
- **Fiber Types:** Pigtails can be single-mode (yellow jacket, 9/125 μm) for long-distance transmission or multimode (orange, aqua, or violet jacket, 50/125 μm or 62.5/125 μm).
