A fiber optic cable access network delivers high-speed broadband from central offices to end users using fiber-optic technology, often through FTTx and PON architectures.

Overview

A fiber optic access network is the “first-mile” network connecting a service provider's central office (CO) to subscribers, enabling high-speed data, voice, and video services . Unlike traditional copper-based networks, fiber networks use optical fibers to transmit data as light, offering higher bandwidth, longer reach, and immunity to electromagnetic interference . These networks are essential for modern broadband services, including video-on-demand, interactive gaming, and enterprise applications.

Network Architectures

Fiber access networks typically use Passive Optical Network (PON) architectures, which include:

- Ethernet PON (EPON): Uses Ethernet frames for data transmission.
- ATM-based PON (APON): Uses asynchronous transfer mode for legacy applications.
- Broadband PON (BPON) and GFP-PON: Support high-capacity broadband services.
- Wavelength-Division Multiplexing PON (WDM-PON): Increases capacity by transmitting multiple wavelengths over a single fiber . These architectures can be deployed in FTTx models:
- FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home): Fiber reaches directly into the subscriber's home....
