Types of Fiber Optic Cable

- Single-mode fiber (OS2): Best for long-distance connections, typically used for demarcation points and outdoor runs. It supports high-speed data over kilometers and is required by most internet service providers for building entry points.
 - Multi-mode fiber (OM3, OM4): Ideal for indoor applications and shorter distances, such as connecting floors, rooms, or devices within a building. OM3 and OM4 support high-speed networks up to 100 Gbps over medium distances.
- Indoor vs. Outdoor Cables: Indoor cables are flexible, fire-resistant, and designed for building environments, while outdoor cables are reinforced to withstand moisture, temperature extremes, and physical stress. Outdoor cables should avoid metal sheaths to maintain electrical isolation
