Cable Jacket Printings

The printings on a fiber optic cable jacket convey critical details about the cable's specifications and intended use. Common information includes:

- Cable type and fiber mode: Single-mode (SM) or multimode (MM), often with core/cladding dimensions like 9/125 μm for SM or 50/125 μm for MM .
- Fiber count: Indicated by numbers such as 12F, 24F, or 864F, showing the total fibers in the cable .
- Buffer and jacket dimensions: For example, 250 μm buffer coating or 0.89 inches cable diameter .
- Mechanical ratings: Minimum bend diameter (MBD), maximum pulling tension, and cable weight .
- Fire and safety ratings: LSZH, OFNR, or other fire-resistant classifications .
- Standards compliance: TIA/EIA, ISO, or other relevant industry standards .
- Manufacture details: Date of production, serial numbers, and sometimes distance markings along the cable . These markings help installers select the correct handling procedures, splicing equipment, and installation methods.
