Types of Armored Fiber Cables

- Interlocking Armor: Aluminum armor helically wrapped around the cable, commonly used for indoor and indoor/outdoor applications. Offers ruggedness and crush resistance .
- Corrugated Armor: Coated steel tape folded longitudinally around the cable, typically used outdoors. Provides extra mechanical protection and rodent resistance .
- Dielectric-Armored Cable: Offers protection without metallic components, eliminating the need for grounding and bonding .

Importance of Grounding

Metallic armor in fiber optic cables acts as a non-current-carrying protective layer. Grounding ensures that any accidental electrical contact is safely discharged, protecting telecommunications equipment, IT systems, and surge protection devices . Proper grounding also complies with industry standards such as ANSI/TIA-607-D and local authority requirements .
