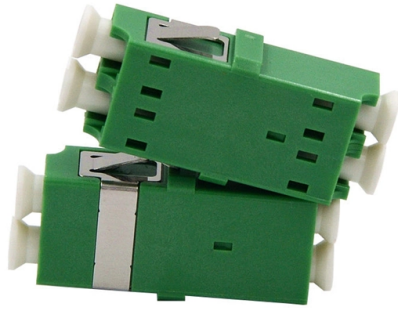


Fiber optic cable splice cannot be pulled out



Overview

Problem: Fiber alignment fails, and the splicing process cannot complete. Solution: Clean the fiber ends to ensure there are no contaminants affecting the alignment. Check that the automatic alignment system is functioning properly and the motors and sensors are intact. A single imperfect splice can disrupt connectivity for businesses, schools, and homes, causing slow speeds, intermittent outages, and costly downtime. Whether it's from misalignment, dust contamination, environmental stress, or poor splice protection, these problems can quickly escalate if not. While a cut or damaged fiber optic cable can temporarily take your network down, it is possible to quickly fix the cable with the right tools.
