Mechanical and Installation Risks

Fiber optic cables are composed of ultra-thin glass or plastic cores that transmit data as light, making them sensitive to physical stress. Excessive bending, kinking, or stretching beyond the cable's minimum bend radius can crack the core or misalign fibers, leading to signal loss or complete failure . Pulling cables with too much tension can exceed their tensile strength, causing permanent damage. Improper installation in trays—such as overcrowding, sharp bends, or unsecured cables—can create friction and pressure points that deteriorate the cable's protective layers . Connectors and interfaces are also vulnerable during installation and maintenance .

Environmental and External Factors

Fiber optic cables can be affected by temperature extremes, moisture, chemical exposure, and physical impacts. Freezing temperatures can damage splice boxes, while high heat can degrade the cable jacket . Natural disasters like storms, floods, or earthquakes, as well as rodent bites or accidental excavation, can sever or crush cables . Over time, aging and static fatigue may also weaken fibers, especially if water ingress occurs in joint boxes
