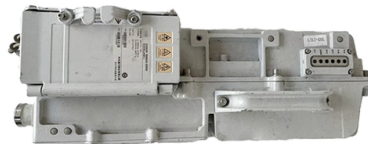

Causes of Damage

A Visual Fault Locator (VFL) can help detect bends, cracks, or breaks by injecting a red laser and observing light leakage . Signs of damage include high insertion loss, intermittent signal, or complete link failure.
