Simplex connectors offer flexibility in network design, allowing individual fibers to be replaced or reordered easily, and are cost-effective due to their single-fiber construction. Duplex fiber optic connectors mechanically pair two simplex connectors into a single assembly, maintaining fixed spacing and polarity between the fibers. This configuration supports bidirectional communication, with one fiber dedicated to transmitting data and the other to receiving it. Duplex connectors are widely used in Ethernet networks and other systems requiring simultaneous two-way data transfer. They simplify installation and reduce the risk of mispairing fibers in dual-fiber transceivers.
