

Fiber optic module plugged into home fiber optic cable



Article Overview

To connect a fiber optic module to your home fiber optic cable, you need to properly terminate the fiber, attach the correct connector, connect it to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT), and then link the ONT to your router.

Step 1: Gather Necessary Equipment

- Fiber optic module (SFP or transceiver) compatible with your router or switch.
- Fiber optic cable (single-mode or multi-mode) with the appropriate connector type (LC, SC, ST) for your module.
- Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP.
- Fiber cleaning tools (alcohol wipes, lint-free cloths) to remove dust or debris.
- Optional tools: fiber cleaver, crimping pliers, epoxy or UV glue if terminating the fiber yourself .

Step 2: Prepare the Fiber Cable

- Inspect the fiber for kinks, bends, or damage. Avoid exceeding the minimum bend radius.
- If the fiber is not pre-terminated, use a fiber termination kit to attach the connector. For example, LC connectors use a latch mechanism, SC connectors use a push-pull latch, and FC connectors use a threaded screw .
- Clean the fiber end thoroughly to prevent signal loss
