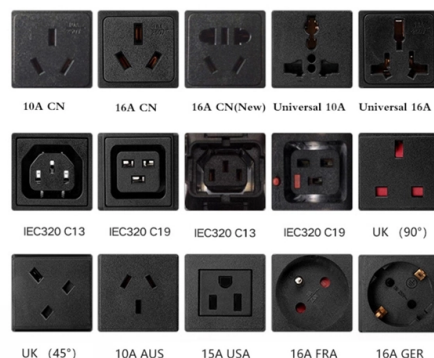


Fiber optic pigtail folding

Fiber optic pigtails should not be sharply folded, as excessive bending can damage the fiber and degrade signal performance.

Handling and Bending Considerations

Fiber optic pigtails consist of a short length of optical fiber with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other, designed for splicing to incoming cables in the field . While the fiber is flexible, it is extremely sensitive to sharp bends or folds. Folding a pigtail beyond its minimum bend radius can cause microbends or macrobends, leading to increased signal loss, back reflection, or even permanent fiber breakage .

Minimum Bend Radius

- Single-mode fibers typically have a minimum bend radius of about 30 mm (1.2 inches) for standard pigtails, though this can vary depending on the fiber type and manufacturer .
- Multimode fibers usually have a slightly larger minimum bend radius, often around 40 mm (1.6 inches).
- The bend radius should be measured from the fiber's centerline, not the outer jacket, to avoid stress on the core.

Proper Storage and Routing
