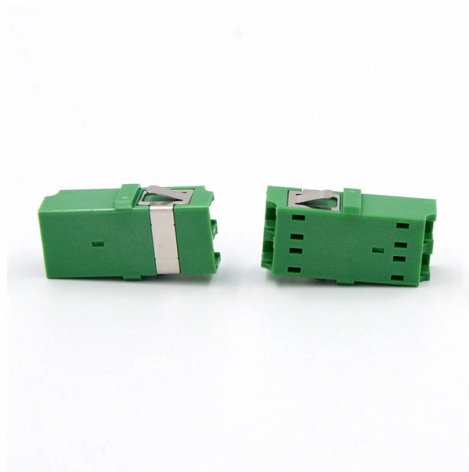


Fiber optic sensor detects transparent objects
