They are typically mitered with a 12" radius to ensure proper cable support and reduce bending strain . 3. Horizontal Elbows Horizontal elbows allow cables to change direction along the horizontal plane. They are available in mitered or pre-fabricated forms and can be integrated with straight sections of fiberglass cable trays for continuous support .

Material and Construction

Fiberglass (FRP/GRP) elbows are lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and non-conductive, making them ideal for harsh environments such as chemical plants, offshore platforms, water treatment facilities, and marine applications . They are designed to withstand extreme temperatures and chemical exposure while providing a high strength-to-weight ratio compared to steel or aluminum .
