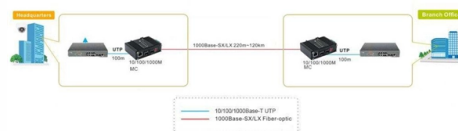


Fiberglass cable tray fixing methods

Key Considerations for Fixing Fiberglass Cable Trays

Material and Load Assessment: Fiberglass (GRP/FRP) cable trays are lightweight, corrosion-resistant, and non-conductive, making them ideal for harsh environments such as chemical plants, coastal areas, and underground utilities. Before installation, ensure the tray's load-bearing capacity matches the total cable weight to prevent sagging or deformation .

Support Structure: Install supports according to design drawings, considering tray route, height, and spacing. Common support methods include:

- Wall-mounted brackets for secure attachment to vertical surfaces .
- Ceiling-mounted rods or trapezes to suspend trays at the correct height, allowing easy cable access and ventilation .
- Floor-mounted bases for heavy-duty or low-ceiling installations . Support spacing should not exceed the distance between splice plates, and fittings should be supported per NEMA FG-1 standards .

Fixing and Fastening: Use appropriate fasteners and clamps, such as B-Line BFPU751 series clamps for beam attachments, ensuring proper thread engagement for load ratings. Torque for threaded rod nuts should be around 3-4 ft.-lbs
