End-face types include PC, UPC, and APC, with APC providing superior return loss performance for high-efficiency transmission.

### Single-Core Patch Cords

Single-core patch cords contain one optical fiber within the cable jacket. They are commonly used for:

- Standard point-to-point connections in data centers and LANs
- Long-distance single-mode applications (OS2, G.652D, G.657A1/A2)
- Short- to medium-distance multimode applications (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, OM5)...
